**REQUEST FOR THE NOTAM REPORT APPROVAL ON COVID-19**

Further to the existing covid -19 control measures, the following shall apply to all flights from India, and all passengers originating from India, as from 1st May 2021, midnight.

1. All passenger flights between Uganda and India are suspended until further notice.
2. No passengers from India shall be allowed into Uganda regardless of the route of travel.
3. All passengers who may have been in India or travelled through India in the last 14 days regardless of route taken shall not be allowed into Uganda.
4. All passengers arriving from India before the suspension date regardless of the route of travel are expected to:
  - i. be in possession of a negative PCR based COVID-19 test certificate that is digitally verifiable conducted within 120 hours from the time of sample taking.
  - ii. undergo a mandatory rapid antigen test upon arrival. All those who turn positive shall undergo a 14-day isolation at a government approved isolation Centre at own cost. Those that turn negative shall be placed under 14-day self-quarantine which will be monitored by the Ministry of Health.
5. The following flights from India are exempted from the suspension.
  - i. Cargo flights
  - ii. Technical stops where pax do not disembark.
  - iii. Aircraft in a state of emergency
  - iv. Operations related to humanitarian aid, medevac and diplomatic flights approved by appropriate Authority.
